1. Purpose. To change the mission statement and delegation of authority for the subject shore activity, assigned to the Chief of Naval Operations for command and support.

2. Modification. Effective 1 October 1981, the following actions are approved:

a. Mission Statement. The mission statement for the subject shore activity is modified to read as follows:

To maintain, command, and operate a world-wide organization to fulfill the investigative and counterintelligence responsibilities of the Department of the Navy (less those combat related counterintelligence activities under the functional responsibility of the Marine Corps); to provide the necessary headquarters staff and operational support to assist in the execution of the mission of the Naval Investigative Service; and to perform such other functions and tasks as directed by higher authority.

b. Delegation. The Chief of Naval Operations delegates authority for the subject shore activity as follows:
