

ALIEN ENEMIES.

AN ALIEN ENEMY IS ANY MALE OR FEMALE OF THE AGE OF
FOURTEEN YEARS AND UPWARDS, WHO IS A NATIVE, CITIZEN, DENIZEN
OR SUBJECT OF ANY COUNTRY WITH WHICH THE UNITED STATES IS AT
WAR.

ANY SUCH PERSON, NOT ACTUALLY NATURALIZED, WHO SHALL
BE FOUND WITHIN THE UNITED STATES OR ITS POSSESSIONS MAY BE
INTERNEED.

The President, however, has declared that so long as they live up to our laws, obey all regulations, and indulge in no seditious utterances, they will be permitted to remain here under certain prescribed restrictions.

When, however, they do not so conduct themselves; or

1. When they make seditious remarks; or
2. Seek information with regard to the movement of our troops or vessels; or
3. Show contempt for our flag, our laws, or our President; or
4. Say that the UNITED STATES had no right to enter the war; or
5. Write, print, or publish any documents or threats against the Government of the United States or against the measures or Policy of the United States or against any person in the Military, Naval or Civil Service of the United States; or
6. When the President shall have reasonable cause to believe them to be aiding or about to aid the enemy; or
7. When he shall deem them to be at large to the danger of the Public Safety of the United States; or
8. When he shall believe them to have violated or about to violate any Governmental regulation or criminal law:

ALL SUCH PERSONS WILL BE SUBJECT TO SUMMARY ARREST
AND CONFINEMENT IN SUCH PENITENTIARY, PRISON, JAIL, MILITARY
CAMP OR OTHER PLACE OF DETENTION AS THE PRESIDENT MAY DIRECT.
