Op. 12. 1. There have been frequent indications in the past few weeks of possible tapping of certain telephone circuits in the Radio Intelligence Section by unauthorized persons. These telephone circuits are those used by the Officer-in-Charge and the Executive Officer of the Section, and would be the logical ones to be tapped by anyone bent on obtaining information concerning radio intelligence activities.
