1. Enclosure (1) details the mission and function of your unit.

2. A unit training program should be implemented which will provide training to reservists under your command to meet the needs of NIS as shown by the mission statement.

3. In order to assist the unit C.O.'s in their training programs, Reserve Officers who work for NIS as civilian agents are currently revamping the entire investigations course and this should be ready for distribution within this fiscal year. In addition, Port Vulnerability studies currently underway by NIS are being assigned to reserve units as mobilization readiness projects and it is expected that a number of additional NIS dedicated units will be participating in this project in the near future. A study is also underway as to the feasibility of a two week ACDUTRA NIS investigators course to be held at various locations throughout the country. NIS agents who are also Naval Reservists will serve as instructors. Subsequent OJT ACDUTRA periods for NIS Unit members will be available at NISO's and at NIS Headquarters. When this course and OJT become a reality it would greatly enhance the training of the reservist in his mobilization assignment.
