


DAVID L. BRANT Director Naval Criminal Investigative Service



Director David L. Brant was born on September 30, 1952, in Danville, Illinois. He received a bachelor's degree in psychology from Bradley University in 1974 and a master's degree in criminology from Indiana State University in 1975. He joined the Naval Criminal Investigative Service (NCIS) in 1977 after serving as a police officer for two years in the Dade County Metropolitan Public Safety Department in Miami, Florida.

Since joining NCIS, Director Brant has served as Special Agent Afloat on the USS Independence (1979-1980); Special Operations Squad Leader at the NCIS Resident Agency, Subic Bay, Republic of the Philippines



(1981-1983); Executive Assistant to the Director of NCIS (1984-1986); Special Agent in Charge of the NCIS Resident Agency Mayport, Florida (1986-1989); Deputy Regional Director, NCIS Southeast Asia Region (1989-1991); Deputy Assistant Director for Counterintelligence (1991-1992); and Assistant Director for Career Services (1992-1993).

During the 1993 NCIS reorganization, Director Brant was assigned as Assistant Director for Administration. He was appointed as Assistant Director for Counterintelligence in July, 1993, and promoted to the Senior Executive Service in September, 1993. He was appointed Director of NCIS by Secretary of the Navy John Dalton in May, 1997.

Director Brant received the Navy Meritorious Civilian Service Award in 1989. He is a graduate of the Senior Executive Course at the John F. Kennedy School of Government at Harvard University.
