Special Agent Briant has over twenty years of government service as an active duty naval officer, civil servant and naval reserve officer. He was commissioned in 1975 and served aboard ship as a weapons systems officer and as an officer agent with NCIS in London, England until his release from active duty in 1980.



Mr. Briant's field management positions with NCIS include Assistant Agent in Charge for Foreign Counterintelligence, Washington Field Office; Agent in Charge, Quantico, VA; Agent in Charge, Fort Amador, Panama and the U.S. Naval Forces South Staff CI Officer during Operation Just Cause. His Headquarters management positions include Chief, Counterintelligence Investigations Division; Assistant for CI Resource Management; and Chief of the Europe, Africa and Middle East CI Operations Division.

Special Agent Briant was assigned in Saudi Arabia as the Deputy Counterintelligence Staff Officer, U.S. Central Command during Operation Desert Storm.

Mr. Briant has had two external assignments as Chief of the Program Integration Office at the National Counterintelligence Center and as the Assistant Director for Counterintelligence Operations in the Office of the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense (Intelligence and Security).

Special Agent Briant is a Captain in the Naval Reserve Intelligence Program and currently the Deputy Director, Northeast Region Joint Reserve Unit, Defense Intelligence Agency, Directorate of Operations.

Mr. Briant is a member of the Senior Executive Service. He is the recipient of the Secretary of Defense Medal for Meritorious Civilian Service, the Navy Superior Civilian Service Medal, the Navy Meritorious Civilian Service Medal and the Operation Desert Storm Civilian Service Medal.
