2. Before any credentials are issued all the provisions of reference (a) must be clearly understood and complied with. See also iustructions on the back of cards.

Persons to whom issue of oredentials it made must understand alearly that reacent appointments as operatives are conditioned upon satisfactory eonpletion of the Training Course now in process of preparation Failure to qualify in the Course will result in cancellation of designation as an operative.
4. While reference (a) now states that only regularly enrolled offioers nay be designated as Investigators, Agents or Special Agents, it is expected to add a sentence to Art. $3(b)$ reading "Civilians regularly employed in investigative work on full time will be classed as Agents. " This sentence may be considered effec. tive at onoe, and aredentials may be issued to such employees in acoordance with Arte 19(c), but in ench case the District Intelligence ofticer shall write a sepm arate report on each person particularly desixed for appointment as "Agent" to ace company the identification card when sent in for Counter-signature by the Disectore
