- must be clearly understood and complied with. See also instructions on the back of cards.
- 3. Persons to whom issue of credentials is made must understand clearly that present appointments as operatives are conditioned upon satisfactory completion of the Training Course now in process of preparation. Failure to qualify in the Course will result in cancellation of designation as an Operative.
- 4. While reference (a) now states that only regularly enrolled officers may be designated as Investigators, Agents or Special Agents, it is expected to add a sentence to Art. 3(b) reading "Civilians regularly employed in investigative work on full time will be classed as 'Agents.'" This sentence may be considered effective at once, and credentials may be issued to such employees in accordance with Art, 19(c), but in each case the District Intelligence Officer shall write a separate report on each person particularly desired for appointment as "Agent" to accompany the identification card when sent in for Counter-signature by the Director.
- 5. When the present issue of material is exhausted, or if considered inadequate, request should be made for additional quantities, stating reasons,
