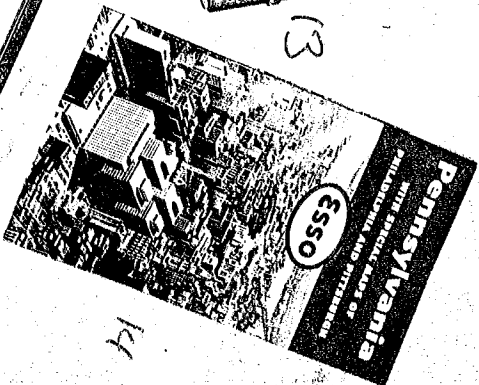
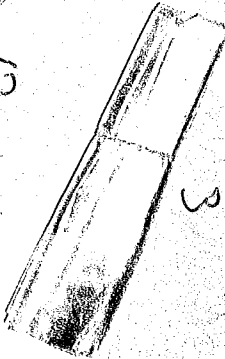
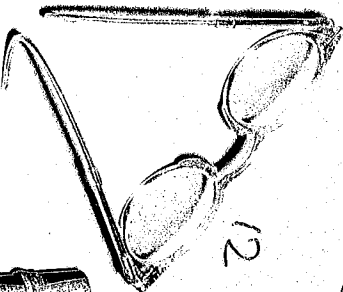
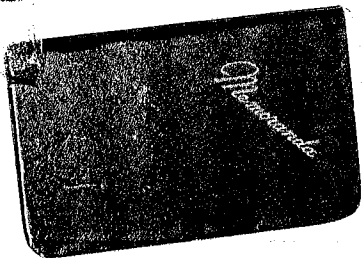
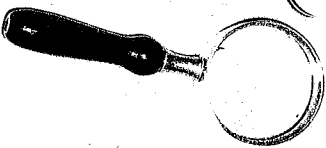
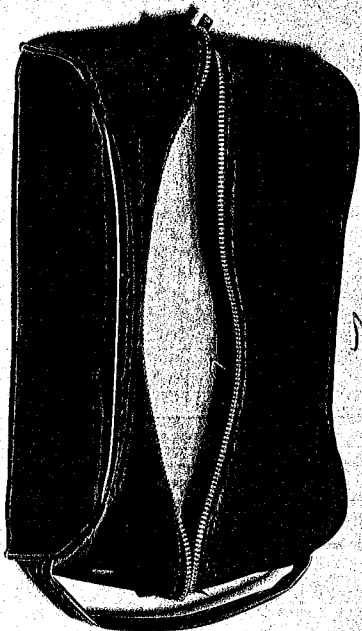
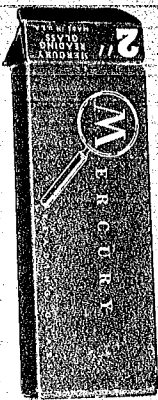
2. Most of the items shown here were obtained from various sources without charge. The carrying case itself is an ordinary shaving kit purchased at most chain drug stores for \$1.00.
