Reference: (a) O.N.I. Circular Appendix B, Ser. Nos. 1735, to 1745 inclusive dated 25 July, 1939 except 1736 which is dated 2 August 1939. In accordance with the above circular, delivery to the District Intelligence Officers of the following listed credentials:

Agents Badges Nos. ~~Inclosure~~ Sample copy of reference (a).

Copies for Identification Purposes. Attached hereto is a copy of a form letter that was sent to the Commandants of the Naval Districts at the time credentials were furnished to the Districts for distribution to Operatives of the Intelligence Service.

2. Before any credentials are issued all the provisions of reference (a) must be clearly understood and complied with. ~~Each District was sent an individual letter; hence, the large number of serial numbers and various districts appearing above.~~

3. Persons to whom copies of Circular B may be made available and to whom present appointments are held in the Intelligence Service in accordance with the terms of the Circular, now in force, of reference (b), reading "Civilians regularly employed in investigative work on full time will be classified as Agents." This sentence may be considered effective at once and credentials may be issued to such employees in accordance with art. 19(b). It is expected that such persons will be regularly enrolled officers or enlisted men in the Intelligence Service. Agents or Special Agents, it is expected to add a sentence to Art. 3(c) reading "Civilians regularly employed in investigative work on full time will be classified as Agents." This sentence may be considered effective at once, and credentials may be issued to such employees in accordance with art. 19(c), but in each case the District Intelligence Officer will make a separate report on each person particularly desired for appointment as "Agent" to accompany the identification card when sent to the Director, Commander, U.S.N. District.

4. When the first issue of credentials is issued, or if considered inadmissible, request should be made for additional quantities by stating reasons.

5. Receipt for the material is desired when received.
