Charles H. Lee, Jr., was born September 26, 1953 in Houston, Texas. He received a bachelor's degree in Political Science from San Francisco State University in 1976. Most recently he completed the Department of Defense National Security Management Course at Syracuse University in 1999.

Special Agent Lee started his law enforcement career in 1973 while in college as a full-time clerical employee with the Federal Bureau of Investigations (FBI). Following graduation from college, Lee was promoted to Investigative Assistant and worked counterintelligence matters for the FBI in San Francisco, California. In October 1977, he joined NCIS and was initially assigned to the Naval Air Station Alameda, California.



Subsequent tours have included Special Agent Afloat on the USS Coral Sea (CV-43); Naval Supply Center Oakland California; Narcotics Squad Leader, Naval Station Pearl Harbor, Hawaii; Assistant Special Agent in Charge (ASAC) Naval Station Treasure Island, San Francisco, California; Head, Crimes Against Property Division, NCIS Headquarters, Washington, DC; Assistant Head, General Crimes Division, NCIS Headquarters, Washington, DC; ASAC, General Crimes, NCIS, Washington Navy Yard; SAC, Naval Air Station Patuxent River, Maryland Resident Agency; SAC, Yokohama, Japan Resident Agency; Special Agent in Charge Yokosuka, Japan Resident Agency; ASAC Midwest Field Office, Great Lakes, Illinois.; ASAC and SAC San Francisco, California Field Office and, SAC of the Los Angeles, California Field Office.

Special Agent Lee is the recipient of Sustained Superior Performance Awards in 1981 and 1983; a Merit Pay Award in 1990 and Performance Awards in 1995, 1996, and 1999. Special Agent Lee is an Eagle Scout and has been active in leadership roles with the Boy Scouts of America throughout his adult life. He is also a member of the National Organization of Black Law Enforcement Executives (NOBLE) and the International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP).
