



Gregg Munroe Special Agent in Charge Marine Corps West Field Office Naval Criminal Investigative Service

Special Agent Gregg Munroe has over 26 years of law enforcement experience. Special Agent Munroe joined the Naval Criminal Investigative Service (NCIS) in 1987 after serving as a police officer with the Coral Springs Police Department, Broward County, FL.

Since joining NCIS, Special Agent Munroe has served at various NCIS offices worldwide and at sea. He began his career with NCIS at the Naval Submarine Base, Kings Bay, GA; subsequently, he was assigned to a variety of offices both in the United States and abroad, which included Keflavik, Iceland; Yokosuka, Japan; Resident Representational Agent, Yokohama, Japan; Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune, NC; Special Agent Afloat, USS John C. Stennis (CVN-74); and Supervisory Special Agent, Naples, Italy. In 2001, Special Agent Munroe was assigned to NCISHQ in Washington, DC, first

as Supervisory Special Agent, Head Operations Division, Personnel Services and Operations Department; then as Division Chief, Cyber Department. In 2004, he served as the Resident Special Agent in Charge, NCISRA Okinawa, Japan.

In 2005, Special Agent Munroe was promoted to GS-15 and reassigned as the Deputy Assistant Director for the agency's Economic Crimes Department at NCISHQ. In 2007, Special Agent Munroe was selected to run the agency's Strategic Planning and Evaluation Department, which was undergoing a significant transformation. In August 2008, Special Agent Munroe was selected as the Special Agent in Charge of the Marine Corps West Field Office, Camp Pendleton, CA.
