NAVAL INTELLIGENCE DIVISION CIRCULAR LETTER DC (C) 5-41

- Subject: Special Employees of the Naval Intelligence Service.

1. Reference (a) is hereby cancelled and superseded by this directive.
2. Special Employees of the Naval Intelligence Service are defined in paragraph 9 of reference (b) as "individuals employed by the Naval Intelligence Service for a specific period of time and for particular tasks." The particular tasks should be of a temporary nature involving a brief period of employment.
3. In view of the fact that Special Employees are employed for particular tasks of a temporary nature, no contracts need be made with them.
4. Special Employees are not to engage in the duties of Special Agents, Agents or Informers.
