Douglas A. "Doug" Tomaso is a native of Chicago, Illinois, and a graduate of John Carroll University in Cleveland, Ohio. After graduating with a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration, he served in the U.S. Army from 1965 to 1968 as an intelligence officer assigned to the 24th Infantry Division.

Special Agent Tomaso joined the Naval Criminal Investigative Service (NCIS) in April, 1974 and serving his initial tour at Marine Corps Recruit Depot, San Diego, California. Subsequent assignments included duty in offices in Rota, Spain; San Francisco, California; Iwakuni, Japan; and returned to offices in San Diego from 1984 to 1986.

From 1986 to 1991, Special Agent Tomaso was assigned to NCIS Headquarters, Washington D.C. During this period, Special Agent Tomaso was Deputy Assistant Director for Criminal Investigations and Staff Assistant to the Deputy Commander. His headquarters tour was followed by assignment to the Submarine Base, Bangor, Washington as the Special Agent in Charge (SAC). Following the NCIS reorganization of NCIS in 1993, Special Agent Tomaso was assigned as the Special Agent in Charge (SAC) of the Puget Sound Field Office.

Special Agent Tomaso was promoted to GM-15 and selected as SAC of the NCIS of the European Field Office which is in Naples, Italy, in June, 1994. In his current position, Special Agent Tomaso is responsible for managing all NCIS operations for a large area of the world. His area of responsibility covers from Iceland to the southern tip of Africa including the Middle East and Russia. He supervises over 60 special agents and over 30 administrative, intelligence operations specialists and investigators.

Special Agent Tomaso is married to the former Rene Miller of Vancouver, British Columbia. They have two children and reside in Naples, Italy.
