NCIS Director Thomas A. Betro appointed Richard Warmack the Naval Criminal Investigative Service's Executive Assistant Director (EAD) for Atlantic Operations in May 2006. This Senior Executive Service (SES) appointment was confirmed in July 2006.

Special Agent Warmack was born in Birmingham, Alabama. He attended the University of Alabama-Birmingham where he earned a BA degree in Education and a teaching certification in 1979.

Following graduation, he served as a Police Officer and Sergeant with the City of Hoover, Alabama Police Department from 1979 until 1984, after which he accepted a position with the Naval Investigative Service in Long Beach, California.

After tours of duty in Long Beach, Yokosuka and Atsugi, Japan, Albany, Georgia, and Naples, Italy, Special Agent Warmack was selected to attend the Naval War College in Newport Rhode Island, where he earned a Master of Arts degree in National Security and Strategic Studies in 1999. Following graduation from the NWC, Special Agent Warmack was assigned to the NCIS Headquarters in Washington, DC where he led the Undercover Operations and Narcotics Investigations Division.

Special Agent Warmack was promoted to the position of Assistant Special Agent in Charge of the Los Angeles Field Office and transferred to the west coast in 2000, and was subsequently promoted to the position of Special Agent in Charge of that office.

Special Agent Warmack was re-assigned to the position of Special Agent in Charge of the NCIS Norfolk Field Office in March 2004.

Special Agent Warmack served on the staff of Commander Seventh Fleet and CINCUSNAVEUR during his assignments in Japan and Italy respectively.
