CAPTAIN BARNEY MARTIN, USN June 1973 - June 1976

Captain Martin graduated from the United States Naval Academy in 1946 and is a graduate of the Naval Intelligence School, the Navy School, Anacostia, for Spanish and French languages, and the Senior Officer's Executive Management Course, Naval War College. He performed cruiser duty with the Atlantic Fleet prior to qualifying as a US Naval Aviator in 1949. His aviation duties consisted of assignments with Air Development Squadron TWO, Electronic Countermeasures Squadron ONE, and the Naval Air Station, Pensacola. Captain Martin was designated Special Duty Officer (Naval Intelligence) and reported to the Office of Naval Intelligence. Subsequently, he held positions as Assistant Naval Attaché, Paris; Head, Attaché Branch, ONI; Personal Aide to the Chief of Naval Operations; Assistant Chief of Staff, Intelligence, Commander Sixth Fleet; Commander, Task Force 157; Military Assistant/Management Analyst on the staff of the Assistant Secretary of Defense (Intelligence). Captain Martin then served as Commander, Naval Investigative Service Command.
