

CAPTAIN PERRY D. HOSKINS, USN 1982 - 1983

Captain Hoskins is a native of Texas where he attended St. Mary's University and the University of Texas prior to enlisting in the Navy as an aviation cadet in 1954. After commissioning and designation as a Naval Aviator in 1956, he served two tours in fighter squadrons (VF-142 and VF(AW)-3). Following these tours, Captain Hoskins was assigned to the Staff of Officer Candidate School, Newport, RI, as a Company Officer. His next assignment was at the U.S. Naval Postgraduate School, Monterey, CA, where he received his bachelor's degree in international relations. He was then assigned to the Staff of Commander Carrier Division One as the Electronic Warfare and Assistant CIC Officer. Following his change of designator to Special Duty Intelligence (1630), Captain Hoskins was assigned to the Defense Intelligence School as a student. Upon graduation he served in the CNO Intelligence Plot and then was ordered to CTF 77 (Attack Carrier Striking Force, Seventh Fleet) as the Intelligence Officer. Subsequent assignments included a tour on the CINCPACFLT Staff; Fleet Intelligence Officer, Seventh Fleet; Naval War College; and Commander Task Force 168, with double-hatting as the Operations Officer for the Naval Intelligence Command. Captain Hoskins was assigned as the Assistant Chief of Staff for Intelligence on the CINCLANT and CINCLANTFLT staffs, followed by his tour as the Commander, Naval Investigative Service Command.
