## TO ALL ENVESTIGATIVE EMPLOYEES:

(J) HIVESTIGATIONS UNDER NAVAL INTELLIGENCE JURISDICTION.

Reference is made to Bureau Bulletin No. 20, First Series 1911, dated June 1, 1941, and particularly to Paragraph E thereof entitled, "Investigations Under Naval Intelligence Jurisdiction."
The instructions set forth in this paragraph were promulgated because of the Navy Department's desires that requests made by representatives of the Naval Intelligence Office for assistance in investigations coming under the primary jurisdiction of that organization should clear through the headquarters at Washington, D. C.

In view of the recently expressed desires of the Office of Maval Intelligence that this rule be abrogated, you are instructed, within the limits of your available facilities, to honor requests for assistance which may be nade by representatives of ONI in investigations coming within the primary investigative jurisdiction of that office. It is no longer necessary for representatives of ONI to clear such requests through the Washington headquarters, and Agents of this Bureau, of course, are not required to secure prior Bureau authority in these cases.
