1. The Paramount Pictures Corporation proposal of 26 September 1967, (enclosure (1) of reference (a)) has been reviewed. The initial reaction to the idea was negative for several reasons. The primary one being that in the majority of cases the enlisted man is the "bad guy" which is not the image which we wish to project. However, a preliminary study of the proposal indicates a desire to portray naval intelligence and naval personnel in a realistic and favorable light. As long as the treatment remains in the tenor described, no objection is interposed by this office with the understanding that our actual files will not be available. However, final judgment must be held in abeyance pending further details of the production theme and format.
