MEMORANDUM FOR THE UNDER SECRETARY OF THE NAVY

Subj: ORGANIZATIONAL MODIFICATIONS

You are directed to review the current organizational structure of the Naval Investigative Service and make the following modifications:

- 1. Replace the current uniformed billet of Commander, Naval Investigative Service with a civilian billet reporting directly to the Secretary of the Navy;
- 2. Establish two uniformed deputies (06) for the new civilian commander of the Naval Investigative Service; one each from the Marine Corps and the Navy;
- 3. Change the name of the Naval Investigative Service to "Naval Criminal Investigative Service;"
- 4. Transfer the responsibility for major procurement fraud investigations to the Department of Defense Inspector General;
- 5. Establish procedures to ensure that requests for action from the Office of the Naval Inspector General receive the highest priority from the Naval Criminal Investigative Service; and
- 6. Recommend which non-criminal activities should be reorganized or transferred outside the new Naval Criminal Investigative Service to ensure focus on criminal investigatory responsibilities.

I request your completion of these items as soon as possible, but no later than 24 November 1992.
