1. The Office of Naval Inteldigence has received reports indicating that persons allegediy engaged in investigations for the Central Intel ligence Agency thave contacted District Intelligence officers and individuals in the Intelligence Conment of the Naval Reserve, Such persons have used a trariety of credentials indicating that they are authorized agents of the $U, S$. Government; the Var Depar tnent; the Central Intelligence Agenay; and in one case, of the Joint Chiefs of Staff.
2. The following is furnished for the information and guidance of all concemed:
(a) The organizations heretefore referned to and known as O.S.S, and S.S.TJ. are no longer in existence,
(b) By agreement with the Central Intelligence Agency investigations of aprilicants for positions thereunder are conducted by $\mathbb{F}$, IT.T.
(c) The Central Intelligence Agenoy does not now naintain nor operate an investigative service in the U.S,
(d) Renresentatives of the Central Intelligence Agenoy engaged in the collection of forefign intelligence from sources within the U.S. are not authorized to conduct investigations, in the generally accepted definition ff that term.
(e) The wrell established and usual chennels through which investigative information is exchanged between the Army and Haval Intelligence shall be strictly adhered to.
