- 1. (C) Purpose. To provide guidance for Naval Investigative Service (NAVINVSERV) handling of RODCA material.
- 2. (S) Background. Reference (a) has not been distributed to NAVINVSERV components. It governs Department of Defense procedures for Reporting on Defense Clandestine Intelligence Activity, which is abbreviated as "RODCA." The term "RODCA" which is unclassified, does not appear on such material, but rather the sensitivity is identified by a codeword which is SECRET and is changed periodically. Reference (a) emphasizes that the strictest "need-to-know" criteria must be applied to all RODCA material and that unauthorized persons must be denied knowledge that elements of the Department of Defense are even concerned with clandestine intelligence activities.
- (S) Action. RODCA material will be handled in the NAVINVSERV in accordance with this Instruction,
- a. When RODCA material is received by the NAVINVSERV it is to be controlled under TICKTOCK procedures in accordance with reference (b). TICKTOCK markings in addition to RODCA markings are required within the NAVINVSERV on material received from other agencies and activities. Disclosure sheets and transmittal memorandums for use solely within the NAVINVSERV are to bear TICKTOCK control superimposed upon RODCA control, and are to be administered by TICKTOCK officers. As set forth in reference (b) this involves disclosure records and other features equivalent to TOP SECRET control.

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- b. If investigation or counterintelligence action is required on RODCA material by local command, response is to be furnished to it under RODCA control. Even though the response does not in itself specify clandestine activity or sensitive sources and methods, as may be the case in a report of investigation or analytical summary of file information. RODCA control must be used in accordance with DoD policy. The local situation and needs of the command being served will determine local use of RODCA by NAVINVSERV components.
- c. DIRNAVINVSERV must be kept cognizant of all actions and furnished copies of RODCA matters involving NAVINVSERV components, and of NAVINVSERV action on them. In accordance with paragraph 3a, above, DIRNAVINVSERV must be furnished such material under TICKTOCK/RODCA transmittal.
- d. There is to be no direct addressing of RODCA messages or correspondence from NAVINVSERV components to NAVINTCOM or DIA. NAVINVSERVHQ will effect all referrals to higher authority and Washington agencies via NAVINTCOM.
- e. Headquarters will keep NAVINVSERV components informed of RODCA codewords.
