: Restrictions on General Visiting Marine Corps Schools

Ref: (a) MCS General Order No. 2 of 1 Jan 1950

1. In view of the increasing possibility of acts of sabotage and other covert actions it is necessary to restrict general visiting on this station.
2. Effective immediately all casual visitors will be refused admittance to this station.
3. Guests of military and naval personnel will be directed to the Provost Marshal's Office. The Provost Marshal or his representative will ascertain whether or not the visit is bonafide and made for the purpose of visiting a member or members of this command. The visitor will then be directed to the quarters of the host or to a meeting place with the host.
4. Members of this command who expect guests should call the Provost Marshal's Office (Telephone 6195) and inform that office of the expected guests who will then be passed to their destination without further inquiry.
5. Commanding Officers of administrative units will establish and maintain a twenty-four hour duty watch to whom the Provost Marshal's Office may refer for locator service. They will inform the Provost Marshal as to the telephone number at which the duty watch may be reached.
6. Present orders of the sentries at the gates permit them to pass members of the armed services who properly identify themselves and these orders remain in effect.
7. The provisions of this memorandum temporarily supersede any directives contained in reference (a) which are in conflict herewith.
