TO: Commandant of the Marine Corps, Washington 25, D. C.

1. Instruction in the Basic Investigators' Course has been arranged for the group of four (4) officers and eight (8) enlisted men of the Marine Corps commencing 16 February 1948. The duration of the Basic Investigators' Course is twelve (12) weeks. Minor deviations in numbers of men and officers sent are permissible.

2. Students must be United States Citizens and should be clear as to character and background. It is preferable but not essential that they be cleared for receipt of classified information. It is highly recommended that in order to receive commensurate benefits from the course, students should have at least the equivalent of a high school education, preferably have completed two (2) years of college.

3. Request that personnel be instructed to report to the Director of Personnel, CIC Center,

4. It is regretted that students for administrative training cannot be accepted at this time inasmuch as the administrative course is in the process of being revised. If desired your headquarters will be notified when the revision has been completed.
