ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JUIN F. KENNEDY NOVEMBER 22. 1063. DALLAS, TEXAS

On November 28, 1963, [Petr 2. Berjabin,] an admitted former Soviet intelligence officer, furnished the following information concerning Lee Hervey Oswald and his wife:

(3) W) Energabia does not believe the Soviet Covernment had any knowledge of Oswald's plans to assassinate President Kennedy: however, he does believe that Oswald and his wife had some connection with the Bussian intelligence service. He said the Soviet Government undoubtedly has a file on Cavald and feels that it should be requested to furnish information regarding Oswald's activities while in the Soviet Union. Normally, when an individual leaves the Soviet Union and has been working for the government, he would be furnished some clothes and transportation expenses to his destination. this was not done, Derjabing feels that Oswald's departure from the Soviet Union was planned by the intelligence service. Oswald must have been investigated upon his arrival in the Soviet Union and probably lived in Moscov while he was undergoing investigation prior to his going to Minsk. Derjable teels that Oswald must have been indoctrinated into the Soviet system prior to his being permitted to return to the United States, or he was considered unstable and allowed to leave as an undesirable. He said Osvald's wife must have been an uneducated peasant type and considered safe to leave the Soviet Union or had connections with the Soviet intelligence service.

Thoriabin believes that the wife of Degald should be observed closely and thoroughly interrogated. * Derjabin suggested that among others, the following questions should be auked:
