(OSWALD)

WASHINGTON--LEE H. OSWALD, ACCUSED SLAYER OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY, ONCE THREATENED TO "EMPLOY ALL MEANS" TO RIGHT A WRONG HE SAID HAD BEEN DONE HIM IN MILITARY SERVICE.

OSWALD MADE THE THREAT IN A LETTER TO TEXAS GOV. JOHN B. CONNALLY JR., WHO WAS WOUNDED WHEN THE PRESIDENT WAS KILLED. AT THE TIME HE WROTE THE LETTER OSWALD THOUGHT CONNALLY STILL WAS SECRETARY OF THE NAVY.

ACTUALLY, ACCORDING TO AN EXCHANGE OF LETTERS MADE PUBLIC TODAY BY THE PENTAGON, CONNALLY HAD LEFT THE OFFICE OF SECRETARY OF THE NAVY.

OSWALD ALSO APPARENTLY DATED THE LETTER WRONG. IT WAS DATED JAN. 30, 1961, BUT APPARENTLY WAS WRITTEN JAN. 30, 1962 FROM FORT WORTH, TEXAS.

IT REFERRED TO THE FACT THAT OSWALD RECEIVED A DISHONORABLE DISCHARGE FROM THE MARINE CORPS.

"I SHALL EMPLOY ALL MEANS TO RIGHT THIS GROSS MISTAKE OR INJUSTICE TO A BONA FIDE U.S. CITIZEN AND EX-SERVICEMAN," THE LETTER SAID.
