"THE U.S. GOVERNMENT HAS NO CHARGES OR COMPLAINTS AGAINST ME.

ASK YOU TO LOOK INTO THIS CASE AND TAKE THE NECESSARY STEPS TO

REPAIR THE DAMAGE DONE TO ME AND MY FAMILY." THE LETTER ALSO REFERRED TO OSWALD'S STAY IN RUSSIA WHERE HE ONCE SOUGHT UNSUCCESSFULLY TO TAKE OUT SOVIET CITIZENSHIP.

HE SAID IN THE LETTER HE HAD GONE TO THE SOVIET UNION "MUCH IN THE SAME WAY AS E. HEMINGWAY RESIDED IN PARIS," AND ADDED:

"I HAVE AND ALWAYS HAD THE FULL SANCTION OF THE U.S. EMBASSY, MOSCOW. U.S.S.R., AND HENCE THE U.SS. GOVERNMENT. AS I AM RETURNING TO THE U.S.A. THIS YEAR WITH THE AID OF THE U.S. EMBASSY (I) BRING WITH ME MY FAMILY (SINCE I MARRIED IN THE U.S.S.R.). CONNALLY RECEIVED THE LETTER AT FORT WORTH, TEX. AND REPLIED THAT HE WAS NO LONGER CONNECTED WITH THE NAVY AND WAS REFERRING THE MATTER TO THEN SECRETARY OF THE NAVY FRED KORTH. OSWALD WROTE FROM AN ADDRESS GIVEN AS KALININA ST., 4-24, MINSK, U.S.S.R. 11/23 -- TD1156AES
