- 1. Enclosures (A) through (G) were delivered to a representative of the District Intelligence Officer, Fourteenth Naval District, on 12 December 1943, by an officer of the Navy Yard, Pearl Harbor. The latter found enclosures at Bachelor Officers Quarters No. 1 at the Navy Yard, upon assuming quarters occupied until

9 December 1943 by Lt. Comdr. John Kremer, Jr., USNR. When found, the enclosures were in an envelope marked only "KREMER."

- 2. On 10 December 1943, the District Air Transportation Officer furnished air transportation for Lt. Comdr. John Kremer, Jr., whose orders directed him to go to Brisbane, Australia, and to report to ComSoWesPac for duty.
- The nature of the enclosures, and the circumstances of their finding, indicate that probably they were last in the possession of Lt. Comdr. John Kremer, Jr., USNR, during his occupancy of a room at Bachelor Officers quarters, Navy Yerd, Pearl Harbor. In view of the fact that the enclosures may be required by Lt. Comdr. Kremer in his present duty, they are forwarded herewith for appropriate disposition.
- 4. Investigation by the District Intelligence Officer of the circumstances of the finding of enclosures indicates the probability that no compromise has occurred. It appears that the enclosures lay untouched from the time they were last in proper custody—presumably in the possession of Lt. Comdr. Kremer— until they were discovered by the officer who delivered them to the District Intelligence Officer.
- 5. Since enclosures indicate the probability that Lt. Comdr. Kremer is working out of the Office of Strategic Services, Washington, copies of this letter are directed to the Chief of Naval Operations (Director of Maval Intelligence) for such notification to the Office of Strategic Services as may be required.
- 6. The urgency of delivery of this document is such that it will not reach the addressee in time by the next available officer messenger. Authority is hereby granted to transmit this correspondence by registered air mail within the jurisdiction of the United States Mail and the Naval Postal Service.
