- All investigations made by the Naval Intelligence Service in the case of applicants for appointment in Class I-V(S), U.S. Naval Reserve. will be reported on Naval Intelligence Service Investigation Report form NNI-119, in addition to form N Nav 544. It will be noted that form NNI-119 is only the cover page of the Naval Intelligence Investigation Report and that reference (d) contains instructions for making out this report and that reference (e) contains complete instructions for the Operative making the investigation.
- In order to assist the Investigators in conducting the investigations in the case of Class I-V(S) applicants, ONI form 1(f) should be filled out by the applicant prior to the assignment of the case for investigation and made available to the investigators.
- All investigations of enlisted men of the Naval Reserve for assignment to Naval Intelligence duties or investigations of candidates for enrollment in the Naval Reserve who will be assigned to the Naval Intelligence Organization for mobilization, must also be reported on form MNI-119.
- A copy of each investigation, whether of an applicant for appointment as a Class I-V(S) officer or for enrollment as an enlisted man, should be forwarded to the Office of Naval Intelligence for its files. Copies of the investigations of rejected applicants are also desired by this office.
