It is understood that there is a question in your mind as to whether or not it is proper for the Naval Intelligence Service to conduct investigations of officers and enlisted men of the Naval Reserve under the delimitation agreement of June 5, 1940, supplemented by an agreement of December 12, 1940.

Please be advised that, under the delimitation agreement officers and enlisted men of the United States Naval Reserve are civilians under Navy employ or control when not on active duty and, therefore, should be investigated by the Naval Intelligence Service when the necessity arises.
