Espionage, Sabotage and Subversive Activities,

Information Regarding Furnished by FBI.

The following statement made by Mr. Hoover in an Interdepartmental Intelligence Conference on May 14, 1941 is forwarded for information.

"Written instructions previously concurred in by the FBI, ONI, and G-2 in Washington, D.C., have been transmitted to all FBI field offices, specifically instructing that all information of any present or potential interest to ONI and G-2 be furnished to representatives of the latter in the field promptly and, further, that these instructions specifically provide that if any doubt whatsoever exists as to whether the information is of interest to ONI or G-2, all doubt should be resolved in favor of furnishing the information to the agency or agencies interested."
