Investigation Reports; Distribution of

- 1. It has been observed in several instances that investigative reports, which have been made in one Naval District and forwarded direct to some subordinate activity (receiving station, ammunition depot, etc.) in another Naval District, have not been forwarded via the District Intelligence Office of one or both of the Naval Districts concerned.
- 2. While such procedure as described above may be desirable or necessary to expedite delivery of the report, it should be evident that the District Intelligence Officer in each district must be cognizant of what is going on in his district.
- 3. Hereafter, whenever investigative reports are forwarded direct to subordinate activities within another Naval District, copies of such reports will be forwarded to all interested District Intelligence Officers.
