2. Intelligence Units should submit their investi-
gative reports, suspect cards, correspondence, etc., via the
District Commandant (DIO) for review, approval and, where neces-
sary, forwarding to the Office of Naval Intelligence, in con-
formity with the spirit of ONI-19, Arts. 302(3) and 375.
