

(J) INVESTIGATIONS UNDER NAVAL INTELLIGENCE JURISDICTION.

Reference is made to Bureau Bulletin No. 20, First Series 1911, dated June 1, 1911, and particularly to Paragraph E thereof entitled, "Investigations Under Naval Intelligence Jurisdiction."
