- 2. Reference (b) is not to be construed as affecting or altering this or any other established procedure for the dissemination of information within the naval establishment. It was designed only to authorize investigations by the Naval Intelligence Service in war fraud cases in which naval personnel are involved and to establish a uniform procedure for the referring of such cases to the Department of Justice.
- prevent extensive investigations of naval personnel by other governmental agencies and will enable the Navy Department to take appropriate administrative action before the institution of criminal or otherwise public proceedings in which naval personnel might be implicated.
- 4. Since, under reference (a), cost inspectors are not required to advise either their respective district Commandants or District Intelligence Officers of fraudulent activities which may come to their attention, an amendment is now being considered by the Bureau of Supplies and Accounts which will provide a more effective coordination of the Cost Inspection Service into the purposes and procedure contemplated in reference (b).
