"The Integration of the Negro into the United States Navy" was written by Lieutenant Dennis D. Nelson II, U.S.N.R., as the thesis for his Master's Degree in sociology from Howard University, Washington, D. C. It is made available to the press by the Navy Department with the approval of Dr. E. Franklin Frazier, head of the Department of Sociology, Howard University.

Lieutenant Nelson, at present on duty in the Press Section, Public Information Division, Office of Public Relations, Navy Department, was commissioned in the Navy February 23, 1944.

Entering the Navy as an enlisted man, Lieutenant Nelson served for 18 months as a Recruiting Specialist, First Class, in Nashville, Tennessee. Following his commissioning at Great Lakes, Illinois, he served as recruit training officer and officer in charge of the Navy Special Training Unit; supervisor of logistic units, Manana Barracks, Pearl Harbor; personnel officer and commanding officer of Logistic Company 515, Eniwetok; and in the Bureau of Naval Personnel (Standards and Curriculum Section) Washington, D. C.

Lieutenant Nelson attended District of Columbia public schools, and Fisk University, Nashville, Tennessee. He has completed graduate work in the fields of sociology and social sciences at Tennessee State College, Hampton Institute, the Y.M.C.A. Graduate School, University of Hawaii, and Howard University, Washington, D. C. His wife and three children reside in Nashville, Tennessee.

As a civilian, Lieutenant Nelson has been a staff member of the Washington, D. C. office of the Recorder of Deeds; labor contract analyzer, Department of Labor; staff member of the Washington, D. C. Recreation Department; field executive of the Cincinnati, Ohio, Council, Boy Scouts of America; and a staff member of the Department of Social Sciences, Fisk University, Nashville, Tennessee. A member of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity.
