1. References (a) and (b) are the current orders pertaining to counterintelligence and counterintelligence credentials, respectively. Reference (c) requested that an appropriate Civilian Clothing Allowance be furnished to the subject named enlisted man, who is presently assigned counterintelligence duties.
2. As outlined in reference (a), personnel filling counterintelligence billets should be qualified for and possess the requisite Military Occupational Specialty. In addition, special counterintelligence credentials will be furnished by this Headquarters for issuance to authorized personnel, but are to be issued and restricted in their use in accordance with current directives. Reference (b) states that credentials will not be issued to personnel who have not completed a formal course of instruction in counterintelligence which qualifies them for MOS O210 or O211.
3. A review of the records at this Headquarters indicate that Master Sergeant COLLIER is not qualified for and does not possess the requisite MOS for counterintelligence duties. It is requested that the Marine Corps Counterintelligence Credential No. 035, previously furnished for issuance to Master Sergeant COLLIER be returned to this Headquarters.
4. In view of the foregoing, the request contained in reference (c), for a Civilian Clothing Allowance for Master Sergeant COLLIER, is not approved.
