OP-92C. THIS GROUP DEVELOPS AND INTERPRETS
POLICY IN THE COUNTERINTELLIGENCE, SECURITY, AND
INVESTIGATION AREAS. IT ALSO DEVELOPS PLANS FOR
ARMED FORCES CENSORSHIP AND FOR TELECOMMUNICATION
CENSORSHIP, AND FOR THE TRAINING OF THOSE NAVAL
RESERVISTS TO BE ASSIGNED TO THOSE FUNCTIONS UPON
MOBILIZATION.

OP-92D. THIS GROUP IS INVOLVED PRINCIPALLY
IN RELEASE OF U.S. INFORMATION TO FOREIGN GOVERN-
MENTS. THERE ARE NATIONAL REGULATIONS GOVERNING

FORMATION DISCLOSURE POLICY COMMITTEE, OF WHICH
REAR ADMIRAL FLUCKEY IS A MEMBER. OP-92D IN-

THE MISSION OF THE NAVAL INVESTIGATIVE SERVICE

--NIS-- IS TO PROVIDE COUNTERINTELLIGENCE AND INVESTIGATIVE SUPPORT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY.

THE NIS IS A WORLD-WIDE ORGANIZATION CONSISTING OF A HEADQUARTERS, IN NEAR-BY ARLINGTON, VIRGINIA, AND 23 FIELD COMMANDS RANGING FROM VIETNAM TO EUROPE. THERE ARE RESIDENT SUB-UNITS IN MORE THAN 100 U.S. CITIES AND IN SOME 25 MAJOR FOREIGN CITIES.

THE NIS HAS APPROXIMATELY 2,000 PERSONNEL, HERE AND IN THE FIELD. IT HAS A HIGHLY PROFESSIONAL INVESTIGATIVE CORPS OF SOME 900 AGENTS. THROUGH AN ARRANGEMENT OF LONG STANDING, THESE AGENTS ARE NOT UNDER CIVIL SERVICE BUT ARE UNDER CONTRACT TO THE DIRECTOR, NIS, AND ARE PAID FROM CONFIDENTIAL FUNDS.
