MEMORANDUM FOR DIRECTOR, NAVAL SECURITY GROUP

Subj: Planning for Relocation of NAVINTCOM

1. In a recent discussion with RAIN HARTMAN (Op-09B), the subject of the long-range plan for the relocation of the Naval Intelligence Command was discussed.
2. While the ultimate goal of consolidating the various NAVINTCOM Field Activities with Headquarters at the Suttle complex was reconfirmed, the wisdom of an interim move to the Naval Security Station was explored. An alternate move to a DOD leased location on Telegraph Road in Alexandria is being examined.
3. Since this is a matter of direct interest to you, I have asked my staff to give you a short briefing on the subject at your convenience. Captain SLOAN (NAVINTCOM-02) will contact you in this regard.

1. The space requirements contained herein are submitted in reference to the proposed relocating of NAVINTCOMHQ to the Hoffman Building. They are submitted as a result of reference (a).
2. Enclosure (1) gives the amounts and types of space which will be required in the Hoffman Building by NAVINTCOMHQ.
3. Enclosure (2) list the special requirements for the Hoffman Building. The physical security requirements for the space occupied by NAVINTCOM should be such, so as to make the total area a CONTROLLED space. It is desired to have a perimeter alarm system with a central control station located in a security office at the main entrance of the NAVINTCOM spaces.
4. Mr. S. L. Rodriguez, extension 71006, will be the liaison for NAVINTCOM and OPNAV for this relocation project.
